Into the Wild: A Family Adventure Workshop Series

The High Desert Museum and the Deschutes Public Library are hosting a new family science workshop series, *Into the Wild: A Family Adventure Workshop Series*, at **no cost to participants**. This is a unique opportunity for you and your child to discover the natural world around you and to spark your imagination and sense of adventure.

Adult caregivers with children ages 6 through 10 are invited to learn together in hands-on workshops where they'll uncover the mysteries of the intriguing carnivores hidden in our local forests. You'll work with wildlife biologists both in the classroom and in the field, learning how to identify animals in the wild, how to track their movements and explore how they survive. Then, you'll share the stories of your discoveries. Together, you'll investigate, research, interpret and share what you've learned.

Workshop dates: Saturdays from 9am-4pm: April 8, April 15, April 22, April 29, May 6 and May 13. Must attend all 6 workshops.

Cost: **FREE!** Families will receive \$150 for participating in the workshop series, gas cards to cover transportation costs and lunch at each workshop.

Reading Logs will be sent home for you to read with your child, turn them in at the end of the month for a celebration!



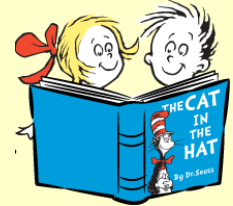
